

FINAL EXAM EXEMPTIONS (Spring 2017)

Number of Potential Final Exam Exemptions:

- During the time frame from Wednesday 4/19/17 through Thursday 5/25/17,
Zero Absences = Three Exam Exemptions
One Absence = Two Exemptions
Two Absences = One Exemption
Three or more absences = No Exemptions
- Science final exams will be taken in the middle of May. They are NOT eligible to be exempted.

Exclusions from Exemptions:

- Any student who spends any time in ISS, OSS or RTDC during the above time frame is rendered ineligible to exempt any exams for any classes.
- Any student who spends two or more days in ASD during that same time frame is similarly rendered ineligible to exempt any exams for any classes.
- Any student with four or more visits to the Reset Room during that same time frame is also rendered ineligible to exempt any exams for any classes.

Grade Requirements:

- Students are permitted to choose the classes they would like to exempt, with a minimum grade requirement. They must have a final average (average of semester one and semester two) of a 75 or higher in the class that they wish to exempt, as of the end of the day on Thursday 5/25/17.

Requirements for Exempt Students on Exam Days:

- Students will report to the Pit if they have earned an exemption for their class during an exam period.
- Students who misbehave in the Pit may be sent back to their classroom and have their exemptions revoked.
- Students who have earned an exemption for a class but who are absent on the day of that class's final exam will have their exemption revoked. They will have to report to take their exam on the designated day for makeup exams.
- Students who lose their exemptions for any reason but do not report for makeups will earn a zero for their semester exam grade.
- If any student has perfect attendance from 4/17-5/25, then he or she will also earn two high school dress stickers, one for each of the last two days of school. This is in addition to the exam exemptions that they earn.
- Students who are ineligible for exemptions for any of the exclusions listed may not earn high school dress for perfect attendance.

Bonus Exemptions!

- Each week, the three grade levels compete with one another for the best attendance rate and the right to earn high school dress. During the last five weeks of the year, the students in whichever grade level has the most weeks with the best attendance will all earn one additional exemption.
- For example, if 8th grade wins 3 weeks, 7th grade wins 1 week and 6th grade wins 1 week, then all exemption-eligible 8th grade students will get one additional exam exemption. This would mean that an 8th grade student who had missed one day of school and earned 2 exemptions would get a bonus exemption, bringing his or her total up to 3.
